Danville Wings Hockey

Josh is the head coach of the Danville Wings. The Wings are a Jr. A Hockey league. There are 10 teams in the league. They play nearly 80 games in a season that lasts from Aug 20th through the playoffs in May. The team was created to provide a place for young men to develop their skills on the ice while focusing on academics, being role models in the community, and providing entertainment for the town.

Wings players have curfews, are drug tested, and either attend high school, DACC, or work, and many of them also tutor at North East Elementary School. They practice every day from 3p-5p.

Five years ago, the Wings were the worst Jr. Team in the league. They had no Division 1 scholarships going to players at that time. Last year the Wings had 10 kids who received Division 1 scholarships, and 2 players who turned pro.
