Kickapoo Carvers

The Carvers meet on the 1st and 3rd Thursdays of each month at the Danville Public Library from 7 to 9 pm.

There are three main types of carving: Chip carving, where wood is removed in order to create the design, relief carving, which has a flat backside, and carving in the round, which is three dimensional and the wood is carved from all sides.

Tools need for carving are available through catalogs and carving dealers, and the wood is purchased from a wood dealer in Eugene Indiana.

The club has national and internationally known carvers that come and teach this art to those interested. They also attend carving shows throughout the Midwest, and are locally involved in the Little Vermilion Fall Festival and at other area shows and festivals.

The carvers are driven to share their knowledge and skill. It is not necessarily a lucrative hobby, but more of a hobby for productive enjoyment.
